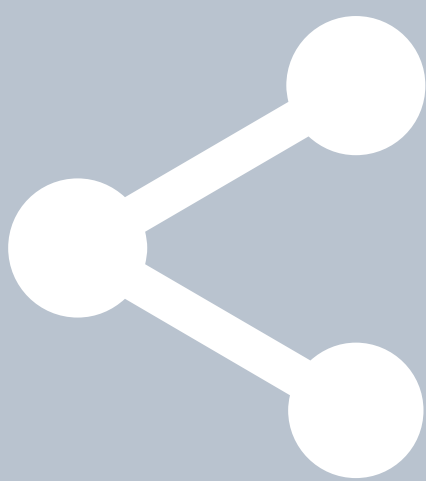


KEEP YOUR PATIENT INFO PRIVATE

WHAT IS PROTECTED

Your personal information, physical or mental health, previous medical treatments, and payment for medical services.

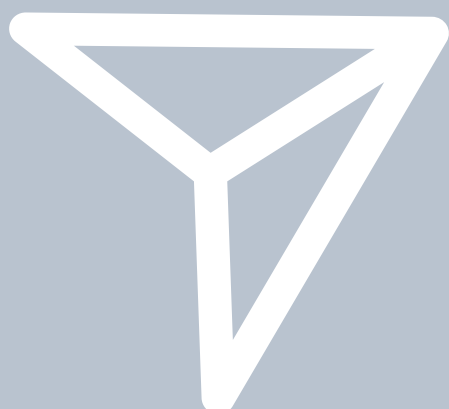
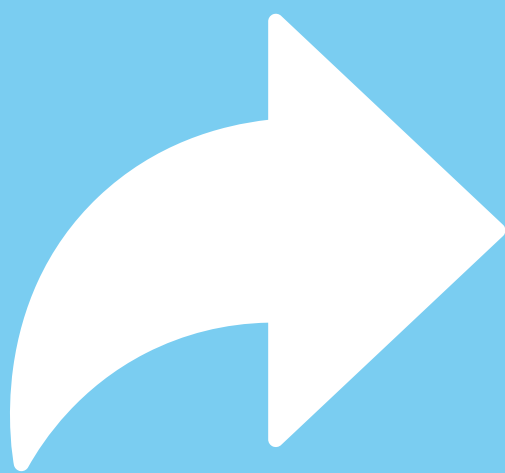


WHY WOULD IT BE SHARED?

- Supplying the data required for benefit payments or health insurance
- revealing details for companies that it requires
- Providing information to law enforcement agencies

WHEN CAN IT BE SHARED?

- info needed for obeying the rules governing workers' compensation
- helping the patient's parent or guardian if the patient is under the age of 18



HOW CAN YOU SHARE

Messages can only be left with family members or relatives

Your info can only be shared with other doctors with the same patient BUT NOT in public places

- mental or physical health



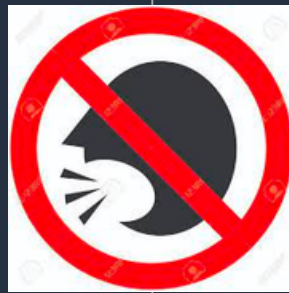
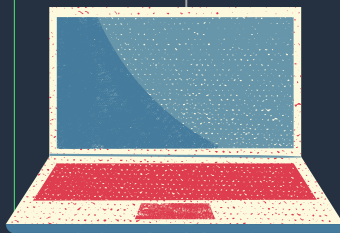

WHEN CAN YOU SHARE INFO

HOW CAN YOU SHARE

- Digitally: Messages can be sent with the patient's permission
- Keeping Records: Avoid leaving paperwork in common spaces
- Verbally: Speak quietly to avoid being overheard



- supplying the data required for benefit payments or health insurance
- revealing details to particular organizations as required by laws governing public health
- obeying the rules
- helping a patient's guardian if the patient is under the age of 18 helping to inform family members of the condition
- helping medical examiners determine causes of death
