
KEEP YOUR PATIENT INFO PRIVATE

You have the right

WHAT IS PROTECTED

Your personal information, physical or mental health, previous medical treatments, and payment for medical services.





WHY WOULD IT BE SHARED?

- Supplying the data required for benefit payments or health insurance
- reveling details for companies that it requires
- Providing information to law enforcement agencies

WHEN CAN IT BE SHARED?

- Into needed for obeying the rules governing workers' compensation
- helping the patient's parent or guardian if the patient is under the age of 18





HOW CAN YOU SHARE

Messages can only be left with family members or relatives

Your info can only be shared with other doctors with the same patient BUT NOT in public places


- Patient's personal information such as address and birthday
